# The Faith Page

## **Pentecost Sunday**

### **Second Reading - Galatians 5:16-25**

Live by the Spirit, I say, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. For what the flesh desires is opposed to the Spirit, and what the Spirit desires is opposed to the flesh; for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you want. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not subject to the law. Now the works of the flesh are obvious: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, anger, quarrels, dissensions, factions, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these. By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things. And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also be guided by the Spirit.

**Adults:** Nine fruits of the Spirit are listed here in Galatians chapter five. Which of the nine are strongest in you; which do you demonstrate most easily? Which are not so apparent in you? Identify two ways in which you can give in to the Holy Spirit and more fully utilize two of His fruits. How will you do that? Which two fruits do you need to let the Holy Spirit develop in you?

**Children:** What are the nine fruits of the Spirit listed in Galatians chapter five? Talk about three times when other people could see a fruit working within you. How can you develop, or demonstrate, these characteristics in yourself? Which fruit do you think you need more of? Is it patience? Is it goodness? Why do you think that?

## **Domingo de Pentecostés**

### **Segunda Lectura - Galatians 5:16-25**

Vivo por el Espíritu, digo, y no satisfaces los deseos de la carne. Porque lo que la carne desea se opone al Espíritu, y lo que el Espíritu desea se opone a la carne; porque estos se oponen entre sí, para evitar que hagas lo que quieres. Pero si eres guiado por el Espíritu, no estás sujeto a la ley. Ahora las obras de la carne son obvias: fornicación, impureza, libertinaje, idolatría, hechicería, enemistades, contiendas, celos, ira, disputas, disensiones, facciones, envidia, embriaguez, juerga, y cosas como estas. Por el contrario, el fruto del Espíritu es amor, alegría, paz, paciencia, amabilidad, generosidad, fidelidad, mansedumbre y autocontrol. No hay ley contra tales cosas. Y los que pertenecen a Cristo Jesús han crucificado la carne con sus pasiones y deseos. Si vivimos por el Espíritu, también seamos guiados por el Espíritu.

**Adultos:** Nueve frutas del Espíritu se enumeran aquí en el capítulo cinco de Galatians. ¿Cuál de los nueve es más fuerte en ti? ¿Qué demuestras más fácilmente? ¿Cuáles no son tan evidentes en ti? Identifica dos formas en que puedes rendirte al Espíritu Santo y utilizar más plenamente dos de sus frutos. ¿Cómo lo harás? ¿Qué dos frutos necesitas para permitir que el Espíritu Santo se desarrolle en ti?

**Niños:** ¿Cuáles son los nueve frutos del Espíritu enumerados en el capítulo cinco de Gálatas? Habla tres veces cuando otras personas puedan ver una fruta trabajando dentro de ti. ¿Cómo puedes desarrollar o demostrar estas características en ti mismo? ¿Qué fruta crees que necesitas más? ¿Es paciencia? ¿Es bondad? ¿Por qué piensas eso?

In 2016, the Atlantic City Office was able to provide food assistance to 1,358 individuals. Over 500 individuals, 50 of whom were homeless veterans, received rent or utility funding in order to prevent homelessness and disconnection. The office has also provided over 1000 changes of clothing, fresh hygiene products, and sandwiches to the homeless on Fridays.

The Atlantic City office, located at 9 North Georgia Ave., is open on Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, and includes a food pantry, free baby supplies, and a thrift store.

Thrift Store Hours: 9:30-11:30 AM Mondays: Adult clothing, Wednesdays: Children & housewares, Fridays (except First Friday): Free clothing to those who provide proof of homelessness.
