# The Faith Page

We attend Mass not only to witness the sacrifice of Christ but to become part of it.

"I appeal to you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God." - *Romans 12:1*

"May he [Christ] make of us an eternal offering to you [the Father], so that we may obtain an inheritance with your elect." - *Eucharistic Prayer III*

## **Ephesians 4:17-24**

Now this I affirm and insist on in the Lord: you must no longer live as the Gentiles live, in the futility of their minds. They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of their ignorance and hardness of heart. They have lost all sensitivity and have abandoned themselves to licentiousness, greedy to practice every kind of impurity. That is not the way you learned Christ! For surely you have heard about him and were taught in him, as truth is in Jesus. You were taught to put away your former way of life, your old self, corrupt and deluded by its lusts, and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, and to clothe yourselves with the new self, created according to the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.

**Adults:** How does this relate to Romans 12:1-2? Be sure to read more of the bible and notice how it is one continuous book of related ideas.

**Children:** Today's reading tells us to change how we behave. We are to make our character fit to the way God wants us to be. What is character? Name two ways you can change your character. How will you try to be more like the way God wants you to be?

## **Efesios 4; 17-24**

**Adultos:** ¿Cómo se relaciona esto con Romanos 12:1-2? Asegúrese de leer más de la Biblia y observe cómo es un libro continuo de ideas relacionadas.

**Niños:** La lectura de hoy nos dice que cambiemos la forma en que nos comportamos. Debemos hacer que nuestro personaje se ajuste a la forma en que Dios quiere que seamos. ¿Qué es el personaje? Nombra dos formas en que puedes cambiar tu personaje. ¿Cómo tratarás de ser más como Dios quiere que seas?

## ***New Changes in Our Parish***

For the last three years, Fr. Pham and Fr. Fernando have served our parish, particularly the Vietnamese and Hispanic parishioners. Fr. Pham also offered the Latin Mass and taught weekly religion classes in the parochial school. Now they are moving onto new assignments effective August 1. Let us pray for the success of their work in their new assignments. Fr. Pham will be the parochial vicar of Christ the Redeemer Parish in Atco.

We will welcome two new priests on August 1: Fr. Cesar Rebolledo Ramirez, who previously served parishes in Camden and Wildwood, and Fr. Andrew T. Pham, a member of the Society of the Divine Word (abbreviated SVD). The Society is the largest missionary congregation in the Church, with 6,000 priests and brothers serving on every continent. It was founded in 1875 in the Netherlands.

With Fr. Pham's departure, the Latin Mass is cancelled. It will not be replaced by an English Mass. I encourage its congregation to attend one of the parish's seven English Masses. For those devoted to the Latin Mass, they may consider the 12:30 PM Latin Mass at St. Gianna Beretta Molla Parish in Northfield.

**NEXT DISTRIBUTION IS AUGUST 20, 2018**

In 2016, the Atlantic City Office was able to provide food assistance to 1,358 individuals. Over 500 individuals, 50 of whom were homeless veterans, received rent or utility funding in order to prevent homelessness and disconnection. The office has also provided over 1000 changes of clothing, fresh hygiene products, and sandwiches to the homeless on Fridays.

The Atlantic City office, located at 9 North Georgia Ave., is open on Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, and includes a food pantry, free baby supplies, and a thrift store.

Thrift Store Hours: 9:30-11:30 AM Mondays: Adult clothing, Wednesdays: Children & housewares, Fridays (except First Friday): Free clothing to those who provide proof of homelessness.
