DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that students who attend Catholic elementary schools and Catholic high schools are far more likely than their peers to graduate high school? 99% of students who attend Catholic elementary and high schools graduate from high school and of those who graduate, 86% go on to 4-year colleges and universities. By comparison, the national high school graduation rate is 84% and only 69% of high school graduates nationally go on to 4-year colleges.

SINCE WE STARTED LOCKING THE SACRISTY DOORS AT STAR OF THE SEA AND ST. NICHOLAS A YEAR AGO, MOST PARISHIONERS BEGAN ENTERING THE SACRISTY THROUGH THE OPEN DOOR FROM THE SANCTUARY. THIS BEHAVIOR CLEARLY DEFEATS THE PURPOSE OF LOCKING THE DOOR, BUT MORE IMPORTANTLY, IT MEANS A CONTINUOUS FLOW OF PEOPLE MOVING THROUGH THE SANCTUARY AND, AT STAR OF THE SEA, VERY CLOSE TO THE TABERNACLE. LET'S SHOW MORE RESPECT FOR THE SANCTUARY, THE HEART OF OUR CHURCHES. AS A GENERAL RULE, THE SACRISTY IS FOR LITURGICAL MINISTERS PREPARING FOR THE UPCOMING MASS - CLERGY, LECTORS, ALTAR SERVERS. SACRISTANS WORK IN THE SACRISTY BEFORE AND AFTER THE MASS AND USHERS ENTER THE SACRISTY AFTER THE MASS TO SECURE THE OFFERTORY. THE SACRISTY IS NOT A "WEEKEND PARISH OFFICE" - THAT'S MORE LIKE THE FUNCTION OF THE WELCOME & INFORMATION CENTERS. IF YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES BRING YOU TO THE SACRISTY, PLEASE KNOCK ON THE DOOR AND WAIT FOR SOMEONE TO LET YOU INSIDE. THE ONLY REASON TO CUT THROUGH THE SANCTUARY IS WHEN YOU'RE THE FIRST TO ARRIVE.

In 2016, the Atlantic City Office was able to provide food assistance to 1,358 individuals. Over 500 individuals, 50 of whom were homeless veterans, received rent or utility funding in order to prevent homelessness and disconnection. The office has also provided over 1000 changes of clothing, fresh hygiene products, and sandwiches to the homeless on Fridays.

The Atlantic City office, located at 9 North Georgia Ave., is open on Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, and includes a food pantry, free baby supplies, and a thrift store.

Thrift Store Hours: 9:30-11:30 AM Mondays: Adult clothing, Wednesdays: Children & housewares, Fridays (except First Friday): Free clothing to those who provide proof of homelessness.

Attention parents and all those interested in enrolling their child in Religious Education,

Students must be enrolled from 1st grade to 7th grade to receive their sacraments. Please provide proof that the grade you enroll your child in is the same grade they're in school. Each year of enrollment is \$85.00 for now. It is especially mandatory for children receiving their Confirmation that the parents enrolling them bring in proof of the present grade they are in. It is important that the children that have not come in for religious education throughout the years to come in for the summer home school program. This program is also \$85.00 and it's for the students that have never been in religious education, so that it completes the two-year requirement.
