We attend Mass not only to witness the sacrifice of Christ but to become part of it.

"I appeal to you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God." - *Romans 12:1*

"May he [Christ] make of us an eternal offering to you [the Father], so that we may obtain an inheritance with your elect." - *Eucharistic Prayer III*

Luke 9: 28b-36

Truly I say to you, there are some standing here who will not taste death until they see the kingdom of God." About eight days after he said this, he took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem. Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. As they were about to part from him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good that we are here; let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." But he did not know what he was saying. While he was still speaking, a cloud came and cast a shadow over them, and they became frightened when they entered the cloud. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." After the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. They fell silent and did not at that time tell anyone what they had seen.

Adults: Does the noise and pace of your life allow you opportunities for quiet prayer? Consider how to find a time each day to have the opportunity to listen more attentively and to find time for quiet prayer.

Children: This is a time for you to stay awake and listen, slow down and pay attention. A time to notice that Jesus loves you and is always with you. Can you think of some ways you can notice Jesus is with you?

Lc 9, 28b-36

En aquel tiempo, Jesús se hizo acompañar de Pedro, Santiago y Juan, y subió a un monte para hacer oración. Mientras oraba, su rostro cambió de aspecto y sus vestiduras se hicieron blancas y relampagueantes. De pronto aparecieron conversando con él dos personajes, rodeados de esplendor: eran Moisés y Elías. Y hablaban de la muerte que le esperaba en Jerusalén. Pedro y sus compañeros estaban rendidos de sueño; pero, despertándose, vieron la gloria de Jesús y de los que estaban con él. Cuando éstos se retiraban, Pedro le dijo a Jesús: "Maestro, sería bueno que nos quedáramos aquí y que hiciéramos tres chozas: una para ti, una para Moisés y otra para Elías", sin saber lo que decía. No había terminado de hablar, cuando se formó una nube que los cubrió; y ellos, al verse envueltos por la nube, se llenaron de miedo. De la nube salió una voz que decía: "Éste es mi Hijo, mi escogido; escúchenlo". Cuando cesó la voz, se quedó Jesús solo. Los discípulos guardaron silencio y por entonces no dijeron a nadie nada de lo que habían visto.

Adultos: ¿El ruido y paso en tu vida te dan oportunidades para rezar en silencio? Considera como encontrar tiempo todo los días para que tengas la oportunidad de escuchar con mas atencion y rezar en silencio.

Ninos: Este es el tiempo para que estes despierto y escuchar, ir mas despacio y poner atencion. El tiempo para darte cuenta que Jesus te ama y siempre estara contigo. Puedes pensar algunas maneras que puedas darte cuenta que Jesus esta contigo?

CATHOLIC CHARITIES

In 2016, the Atlantic City Office was able to provide food assistance to 1,358 individuals. Over 500 individuals, 50 of whom were homeless veterans, received rent or utility funding in order to prevent homelessness and disconnection. The office has also provided over 1000 changes of clothing, fresh hygiene products, and sandwiches to the homeless on Fridays.

The Atlantic City office, located at 9 North Georgia Ave., is open on Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, and includes a food pantry, free baby supplies, and a thrift store.

Thrift Store Hours: 9:30-11:30 AM Mondays: Adult clothing, Wednesdays: Children & housewares, Fridays (except First Friday): Free clothing to those who provide proof of homelessness.

Catholic Charities' case managers in Atlantic County provide a wide variety of services. Some examples are utility and rental assistance, disaster services in response to Hurricane Sandy as well as the Atlantic City casino closings, assistance to veterans who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, and financial coaching and education which includes the opportunity for clients to open matched savings accounts which can be used for them to purchase a home, start a business, or further their education.

BEGGARS POLICY

At recent meetings, the pastoral council has discussed the challenge of beggars on our grounds and in our churches. The council approved this policy.

1. Soliciting money from parishioners and others on our property is grounds for immediate removal by staff or police. Therefore, parishioners are asked not to encourage solicitors by giving money.

If you have been solicited, you may report it to the Welcome & Information Center or an usher. If you want to help personally, a safe alternative to giving money is buying food at the 7 Eleven locations next to Star of the Sea and St. Nicholas.

2. Beggars are welcome to come to the parish office during weekday business hours or to the Welcome & Information Center during weekend Masses. At the office, they can receive a light meal and a personal referral to a social service agency. At both the office and the Welcome Centers, they can receive a package with a pair of socks, a hat and/or gloves.

3. Homeless are generally welcome to sleep in the parish churches outside of Mass. Sleeping during Mass, however, is grounds for removal from the church.

If someone is sleeping during Mass, you may report it to the Welcome & Information Center or an usher.
